HOW TO MAKE VEGGIE DOG BISCUITS

Dogs love biscuits! They especially love fresh, homemade ones! Veggie Dog Biscuits are easy to make. You can help the animals that are cared for by Sacramento County Animal Care & Regulation by making them in your home and donating them to the shelter. Making Veggie Dog Biscuits can be used to fulfill community service requirements, as a youth group project or as a personal project!

Ingredients:

2 1/2 cups whole wheat or white flour ½ cup powdered milk 1 teaspoon garlic powder 1 cup mixed peas & carrots – cooked or canned

6 tablespoons vegetable oil 1 egg - raw 1/4 cup cold water

Directions:

- 1. Mix together first three ingredients.
- 2. Drain & mash up peas & carrots, add to mixture, along with oil & egg.
- 3. Add cold water to make firm dough. Use more water if dough is too dry.
- 4. Kneed dough with floured hands or on a floured surface. A sheet of wax paper on a table or counter works well. It is okay to separate dough into two balls and kneed each one separately.
- 5. Roll dough with a rolling pin or flatten with your hands until it is about ¼" thick. Keep a little flour nearby to sprinkle in case the rolling pin or your hands get sticky.
- 6. Cut dough with your favorite cookie cutter, or use a butter knife to make shapes.
- 7. Make a greased cookie sheet by using a bit of vegetable oil on a paper towel and wiping over surface of cookie sheet, or use a butter or margarine wrapper.
- 8. Place biscuits on cookie sheet.
- 9. Bake in a 350 degree oven for 40 minutes. You may turn biscuits over after 20 minutes.
- 10. Let biscuits cool for an hour. Place in a paper or plastic bag.
