

ANIMAL LICENSE APPLICATION – COUNTY OF SACRAMENTO

Sacramento County Code 8.24.030/8.25.030 requires that all dogs and cats over four months of age be vaccinated against rabies, and licensed. The rabies vaccination, which must be valid through the license year, is a mandatory prerequisite to the issuance of the license.
